RACE: Are We So Different? — a featured exhibition hosted by the North Carolina Museum of Natural Sciences April 22 through October 22, 2017 — is the first national exhibition to tell the stories of race from the biological, cultural and historical points of view. Combining these perspectives offers an unprecedented look at race and racism in the United States.

Private groups can participate in a Cultural Conversation, a 90-minute dialogue facilitated by local experts in the fields of race relations and social justice. This exercise allows for small groups (5–25 people) to have a meaningful and transformative experience as they reflect on the "RACE" exhibition and their everyday lived experiences with race.
