Accessibility and Information Buddies—trained volunteers who can assist guests, including those with disabilities, with wayfinding and information during events.

Guests Who Have Autism or Sensory Processing Disorders



Quiet Space—a space to get away from the crowds with noise canceling headphones, seating, coloring, and calming sensory toys. For location, see the event map.



Noise Canceling Headphones are available for free from the Quiet Room.

Guests Who Are Blind or Low Vision



Sighted Guides—Accessibility and Information Buddies can assist guests who are blind or low vision as a sighted guide.

Guests Who Are Deaf or Hard of Hearing



Sign Language Interpretation for live "onsite" presentations or program is available upon request 2 weeks in advance. Sign language interpretation for live virtual presentation or programs is available upon request 1 week in advance. Please contact Coordinator of Accessibility and Inclusion to make arrangements.



Assistive Listening Devices are available for free upon request for live programs or presentations on a first-come, first-served basis.



Live captioning is available for all virtual programs, presentations, and classes upon request. Please email accessibility@naturalsciences.org at least 72 hours in advance with requests.

Accessible Restrooms—all public restrooms in the Nature Exploration Center and Nature Research Center have accessible stalls.



Elevators operate between each level of the Nature Exploration Center and Nature Research Center.



Accessible Seating is available in the WRAL 3D Theater for guests using scooters or wheelchairs.



Automatic Doors are located at the entrances to the Nature Exploration Center and Nature Research Center. There are automatic doors on the 2nd floor bridge that connects the two buildings. Guests are cautioned there are currently no automatic doors on the 3rd floor bridge that connects the two buildings.

Baby Changing Stations are located in all public and single use restrooms in the Nature Exploration Center. In the Nature Research Center, they are located on the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd floor women's public restrooms and 1st floor men's public restroom.



Nursing Room is located on the 1st floor of the Nature Exploration Center.

Guests Who Use Private Restrooms



Single Use Restrooms are located on the 1st and 3rd floors of the Nature Exploration Center and 1st floor of the Nature Research Center.



Adult Changing Table is located on the 1st floor of the Nature Exploration Center.
